


What are families up to when they travel?

Popularity of Family Accommodation Types






When asked about all-inclusive offerings and client requests, survey respondents said (ranked in order of most important to least):

- Increased interest in eco-friendly resorts




Only 9% of survey respondents said that sustainable offerings are VERY IMPORTANT for their clients.

Emerging Trends in Family Cruise Destinations




Popularity of cruises that mix relaxation with cultural stops

52% of survey respondents say that there's an increased demand for travel insurance.


IS GLAMPING GAINING IN POPULARITY?
